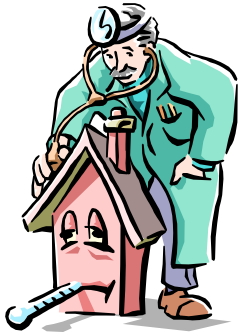


Housing repairs available from City of Temple for a limited time only



If you can answer Yes to the following questions you may qualify for a forgivable or repayable loan to repair your home.

1. Do you own your own home?
2. Is it within the city limits of Temple?
3. Is your gross yearly income at or below the limits shown below?

If you answered yes to these questions, then you meet the basic eligibility requirements for assistance under the HOME Program. The City of Temple has received HOME Program Services from the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs. The funds will be used to assist eligible homeowners to complete repairs to their homes. You are encouraged to attend one of the public meetings to be held on October 20, 2009. The first to be held at 3:00 pm at Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church, 707 South 6th and the second at 5:30 pm at Wilson Park Recreation Center, 2205 Curtis B. Elliott Dr. Topics to be discussed include:

- How to qualify for this program
- Income limits
- Available funding & Number of Projects
- Eligible funding activities
- Project Scoring

Applications must be turned in at City Hall, 2 North Main Street, Temple, Texas 76501. Application deadline is Tuesday November 3, 2009. Special assistance in obtaining application forms is available upon request for persons with disabilities. Persons with disabilities and/or individuals who require auxiliary aids or services for this meeting should contact City Hall at least two days before the meeting so that appropriate arrangements can be made.
